The History of Las Vegas

Las Vegas ("The Meadows" in Spanish) was founded as a city on May 15, 1905. The Nevada Legislature created Clark County on July 1, 1909. The new county was named after William Clark, who brought the railroad to southern Nevada. Las Vegas became the county seat. At that time, Las Vegas was only 19.18 square miles and had a population of approximately 800.

Beginning in 1931, the construction of Hoover Dam brings an influx of construction workers which starts a population boom and gives the Valley's economy, which was in the grips of the Great Depression, a needed boost. While gambling took place illegally for many years, it was officially legalized in March 1931 by the state legislature.

On a percentage basis, Las Vegas and Clark County experienced incredibly high growth rates starting in the 1930s and lasting until the late 2000s recession. During that period, the population of the city more than doubled in most decades. By 2000, Las Vegas was the largest city founded in the 20th century.

Despite the success, the home mortgage crisis and the late 2000s recession affected the economic success. While the city seems to be weathering the unprecedented recession, a slow recovery is predicted. Las Vegas has still managed to host many conventions and major events.

Las Vegas is commonly referred to as The Entertainment Capital of the World. Las Vegas is known across the globe for being a world-class destination.

TRANSPORTATION

Registering your vehicle

Students and active duty personnel (including dependents) do not need to register their vehicles or acquire a new license in Nevada as long as the individual is not employed in the State of Nevada. Vehicles must be currently registered with the home state of valid insurance and driver's license.

Out-of-state drivers and vehicle registrations can be used by new residences for up to 30 days or before the prior items expire, whichever comes first. At any time during that 30 days, they may be turned in to the DMV for Nevada documents.

Nevada law requires motorists to notify DMV of a change of address within 30 days of the move. Keeping your address current is important so they can send renewal notices in the mail.

Monorail

From one end of the Strip to the other, visitors will be able to glide above the traffic at speeds of up to 50 mph. The system operates on a 4 mile route that runs from the Sahara Hotel to the MGM Grand. Whether you are in town for business or pleasure, check out the monorail. COMMUNITIES



Northeast Area

Aliante

This is the "flagship master-planned development of North Las Vegas. It has 1,165 acres to be dedicated to residential and 100 acres for commercial development. Amenities include an 18-hole championship golf course, parks, and a 24-mile trail system.



Mountains Edge

Northwest Area

Red Rock Country Club

Red Rock composes 735-acres of exclusive and personalized homes and features two 18-hole golf courses designed by Arnold Palmer. Red Rock Country Club covers 42,000 square feet, and borders the Red Rock Canyon National Conservation Area, providing panoramic views of the Las Vegas valley. The clubhouse features recreational and social pursuits, including an aquatic center, fitness facility and tennis center.



Inspirada

Located in the southern foothills of the Las Vegas Valley, this community features an diverse blend of architectural styles. The residential villages feature choices from brownstones to estate homes that surround a city center filled with restaurants, shops, offices and other commercial amenities.



Providence

Providence is located on 1,200 acres in the upper west side of the Las Vegas Valley. Ideally situated on a high valley shelf with a dramatic mountain backdrop to the west and spectacular city lights to the east, Providence boasts a setting unmatched by any other master planned community. While residents will cherish the feeling of being "a world away" from the city below, they also will have convenient access to every comfort imaginable.



Summerlin

Located on the West foothills of the valley, Summerlin is unfolding in villages, each centered around its own major park, golf course or major amenity. Currently, there are 17 villages, eventually, the community will be home to 30 villages. Each Summerlin village has its own distinctive style of architecture and design, evident in streetscapes, landscaping and village walls. Summerlin is exclusive home to the PGA Tour Tournament Players Club stadium golf course here in Nevada. It features a private 18 hole championship course in the hills near Town Center Drive and Summerlin Parkway.



Southeast Area

Southern Highlands

Located in the southwestern valley, with easy access to I-215, the "strip" and US 95. Many homes are being built on the Golf Course, which features a 42,000 s.f. clubhouse with library, wine room, dining and shops. The north end is "The Estates", centered around the Southern Highlands Golf & Country Club. The south end of the community is "The Villages at Southern Highlands".

Green Valley Ranch

Accountability Reports are available online from the Clark County School District's web site at www.ccsd.net on the "Schools" link then on School Accountability Reports.

Age Requirements

Nevada law requires school attendance between ages 7 and 18. Kindergarten is part of the regular school program. A child must be five years old on or before September 30 to attend kindergarten and must be six years old on or before September 30 to enter first grade. State law requires that a child must attend a state-approved kindergarten program or take a developmental assessment test to enter first grade.

Bus Services

Students who live more than 2 miles from zoned schools are eligible for bus transportation. Those who are eligible must fill out an application form requesting the service. The forms are available throughout the Clark County School District. Bus times and route schedules can be obtained through your child's school or at www.ccsd.net/transportation. Students with zone variances will NOT be bused. Parents will be responsible for the child's transportation to and from school.

Meals at School

All schools give students the opportunity to purchase breakfast and hot lunches. Elementary schools average \$1.00 for breakfast and \$1.50 for lunches. Middle/High Schools average \$1.25 for breakfast and \$2.00, \$2.50 or \$3.00 for lunches. For students in kindergarten through the 8th grade, applications for free reduced-price meals can be found at the school's office or cafeteria.

Enrollment

In order to enroll students:

Must have proof of immunizations before classes begin

Parents entering their children in a District School for the first time must have identification, child's social security number, and two forms of proof of address. Proof of child's identity can be the original birth certificate or passport. Identification must be an original – no copies are accepted. The required proof of address can be a recent utility bill, rent receipt, residence lease or sales contract. Telephone bills, cable bills, and driver's license are not accepted as proof of address. All students who are transferring from another school district require transcripts or report cards from the previous school.

Immunizations

Nevada law requires that children in kindergarten through grade 12 are current with their immunizations before they are allowed to enter school. Parents/guardians are to bring immunization records with them to school when they register their child.

A child will not be allowed to attend school without documentation of immunizations. Exceptions are permitted for "religious objections," which requires a letter from the parent or guardian stating the religious objection, or for a medical condition, which requires a letter from a health care provider. For the new school year, students must be up to date with all required immunizations. Students entering 7th grade also must have the recently-mandated Tdap vaccine which protects against tetanus, diphtheria and pertussis, or whooping cough. Students new to Nevada are required to have immunizations for hepatitis A and B, and varicella (chicken pox). If a child has had chicken pox, the parent or guardian must sign a "Verification of Disease" form, which is available at each school. A second dose of MMR is required for all kindergarten and 1st-grade students. Contact the Clark County Health District at 383-1351 for more information.

HIGHSCHOOL GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

To graduate from the CCSd, students must complete their required course work and pass the Nevada High School Proficiency Exams in reading, writing and math. (A science exam will be added for the class of 2010). Students who enter ninth grade must earn 22 ½ credits in the following subjects:

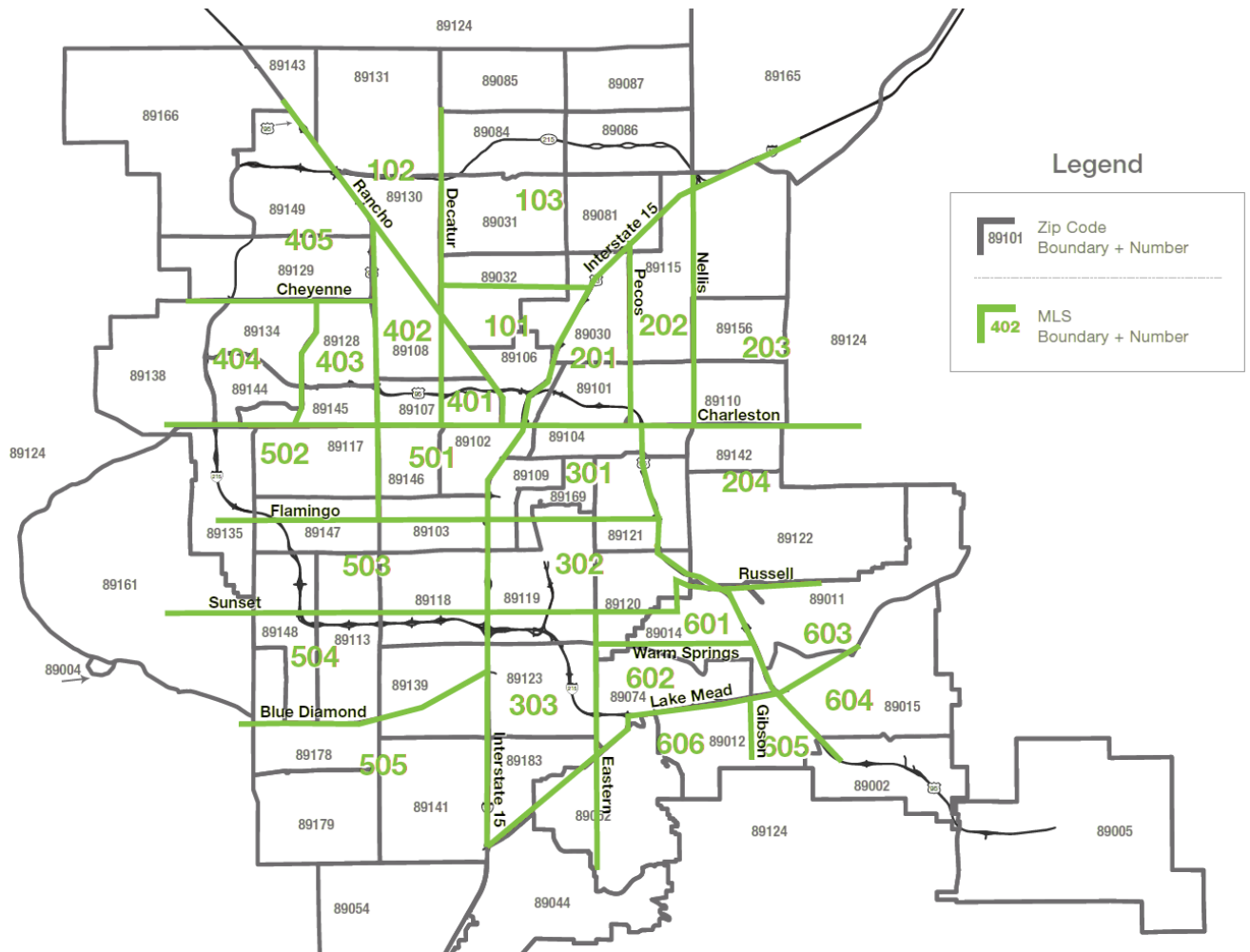

Taxes

Las Vegas has NO PERSONAL INCOME TAX. There is no state income, inheritance, gift or estate taxes.

Inventory or corporate taxes are levied. The low overall taxes has made Las Vegas a hot-spot for industrial and professional growth.

The Clark County Assessor's Office determines the taxable value of each parcel of land - improved or unimproved. This value is multiplied by 35% to acquire the assessed value of the property.

There are several tax districts in Clark County.

Property Tax Due Dates

Payments are made quarterly and as follows:

1st Quarter: 3rd Monday of August

2nd Quarter: 1st Monday of October

3rd Quarter: 1st Monday of January

4th Quarter: 1st Monday of March

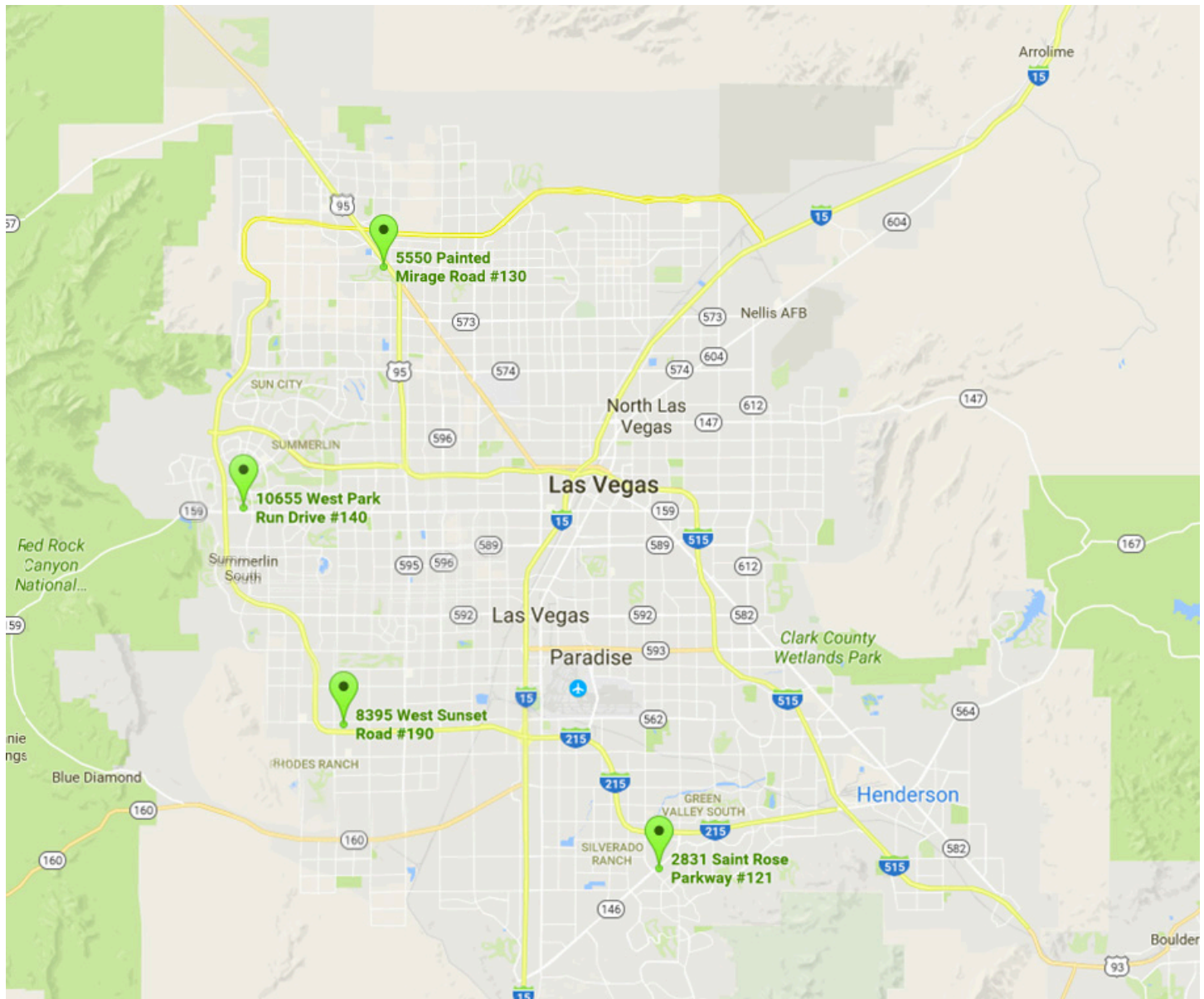
