Did you know...

Northern Arizona is part of the Colorado Plateau, a vast high-elevation region known for its dramatic landscapes, towering pine forests, and iconic natural wonders. This region includes the Grand Canyon, parts of the Painted Desert, and stretches across Northern Arizona, Utah, Colorado, and New Mexico—offering cooler temps, higher elevations, and some of the most stunning scenery in the Southwest.

The History of Northwest Arizona

The story of Northwest Arizona is deeply rooted in frontier exploration, mining booms, and the legendary Route 66. Long before settlers arrived, the region was home to Indigenous peoples including the Hualapai, Havasupai, Mojave, and Paiute tribes, many of whom still live in the area today.

In the mid-1800s, U.S. Army expeditions explored the rugged terrain, and Fort Mohave was established in 1859 to protect settlers and trade routes. The discovery of gold and silver in the surrounding hills led to a rush of miners and prospectors, establishing towns like Oatman and Chloride, which boomed in the late 1800s and early 1900s. Kingman, founded in 1882 as a railroad hub along the Atlantic and Pacific Railroad, quickly grew into a regional center for mining, ranching, and transportation.

By the 1920s, Northwest Arizona had become a vital stretch along U.S. Route 66, "The Mother Road." Towns like Kingman, Hackberry, and Seligman thrived on tourism and travelers crossing the desert on their way to California. Even today, these towns celebrate their Route 66 legacy with vintage motels, diners, and museums.

During World War II, Kingman Army Airfield became one of the largest gunnery training bases in the country, playing a critical role in preparing airmen for combat. After the war, Lake Havasu City was developed in the 1960s by entrepreneur Robert McCulloch as a planned community and recreational destination. In 1968, he famously purchased and reconstructed **the historic London Bridge**, creating a tourism boom that still fuels the city today.

Over the decades, Northwest Arizona has evolved from a rugged frontier to a beloved destination for retirees, vacationers, outdoor enthusiasts, and history buffs alike. With the Grand Canyon to the northeast, the Colorado River to the west, and a rich blend of small-town charm and wild western heritage, this region continues to thrive as one of Arizona's most distinctive and storied landscapes.

CLIMATE

Northern Arizona offers a striking contrast to the desert heat of the south, with a four-season climate shaped by higher elevations and mountainous terrain. Cities like Flagstaff, Prescott, and Kingman enjoy cooler summers and crisp winters. Average high temperatures in the summer typically range from the mid-80s to low 90s °F (29–34 °C), making it a popular retreat from the scorching heat of the lower desert. In winter, snowfall is common—especially in areas like Flagstaff, which averages over 100 inches of snow annually. This region's mild summers, colorful autumns, and snowy winters make it one of Arizona's most climate-diverse and scenic destinations.

You Can Ski in Arizona! Northern Arizona is home to the Arizona Snowbowl near Flagstaff, where you can hit the slopes with views of the Grand Canyon on clear days. Yes—skiing and snowboarding in the desert state is a real thing!



London Bridge Really Is in Lake Havasu. The actual 1830s London Bridge was purchased by developer Robert McCulloch in 1968, shipped stone-by-stone from England, and reconstructed in Lake Havasu City—making it one of the most unexpected historical landmarks in the Southwest.



Route 66 Runs Right Through It. Northwest Arizona boasts some of the most iconic and best-preserved stretches of historic Route 66, with classic Americana stops in Kingman, Seligman, and Hackberry that celebrate the golden age of road trips.

REGISTERING YOUR VEHICLE

Drivers who have relocated to Arizona are required to obtain an Arizona driver's license and register their vehicles in this State. Motor Vehicle Division (MVD) offers services for vehicle title and registration and for obtaining a new Arizona driver license.

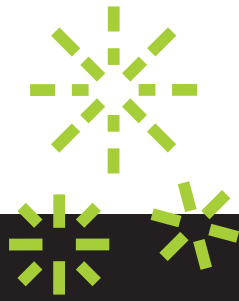

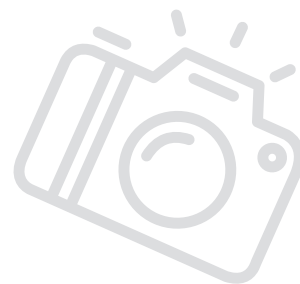

MEALS AT SCHOOL

Schools throughout **Northern Arizona** offer students the opportunity to enjoy breakfast and hot lunches each school day.

The public school systems in Northern Arizona—including districts in **Flagstaff, Prescott, Kingman, Lake Havasu City, and surrounding areas**—serve tens of thousands of students. In addition to public schools, the region is home to a variety of **private, charter, parochial, and boarding schools** that provide alternative education options. Most schools in Northern Arizona begin in **early to mid-August** and **conclude in late May**. **Check with your local school district for specific meal policies and school calendars.**

Typical offerings include:

- Free breakfast available to all students in many districts
- K-12 lunch served daily
- Lunch cost averages around \$3.00–\$3.25 depending on the district
- Applications for free or reduced-price meals are available at each school's main office or cafeteria

ENROLLMENT

Many Northern Arizona school districts offer **online registration**. Visit your local district's website or use www.azed.gov to find your district. If you need assistance with enrollment, contact the school district office in your area for support.

Required Documents to Enroll:

- Certified copy of the child's birth certificate
- Immunization records (must be current and up to date)
- Proof of residency (e.g., recent utility bill, lease, or mortgage statement)
- Parent/Guardian ID (driver's license, state ID, or passport)
- Withdrawal form or records from the previous school (if applicable)

IMMUNIZATIONS

To help protect your child, Arizona state law requires all students to be completely immunized before attending school. Arrangements for immunizations can be made through your family physician or with the county health department. The law allows for exemptions. However, the County Health Department may request that we exclude children who have not been immunized from school in the event of an epidemic. Special forms, available in the health office, must be completed for an exception to the immunization requirement.

The Health Services Department page has the most up-to-date information regarding immunizations.

A minimum number of units of credit are required for graduation by the Arizona State Board of Education. Listed below are the units that must be completed before a student may receive a high school diploma. Graduation requirements may be met as follows (see next page):



HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Graduation requirements as determined by the Arizona State Board of Education (R7-2-302.02) and the District Governing Board are as follows:

- By successful completion of subject area course requirements.
- By mastery of the standards adopted by the State Board of Education and other competency requirements for the subject as determined by the Governing Board in accord with A.A.C. R7-2-302.02 and rules established by the Superintendent.
- By earning credits through correspondence courses (limited to one [1] in each of the four [4] major subject areas) and/or by passing appropriate courses at the college or university level if the courses are determined to meet standards and criteria established by the Board and in accord with A.R.S. 15-701.01.
- By the transfer of credits as described in Policy JFABC.
- * An out-of-state transfer student is not required to pass the competency test to graduate if the student has successfully passed a statewide assessment test on state adopted standards that are substantially equivalent to the State Board Adopted Academic Standards.

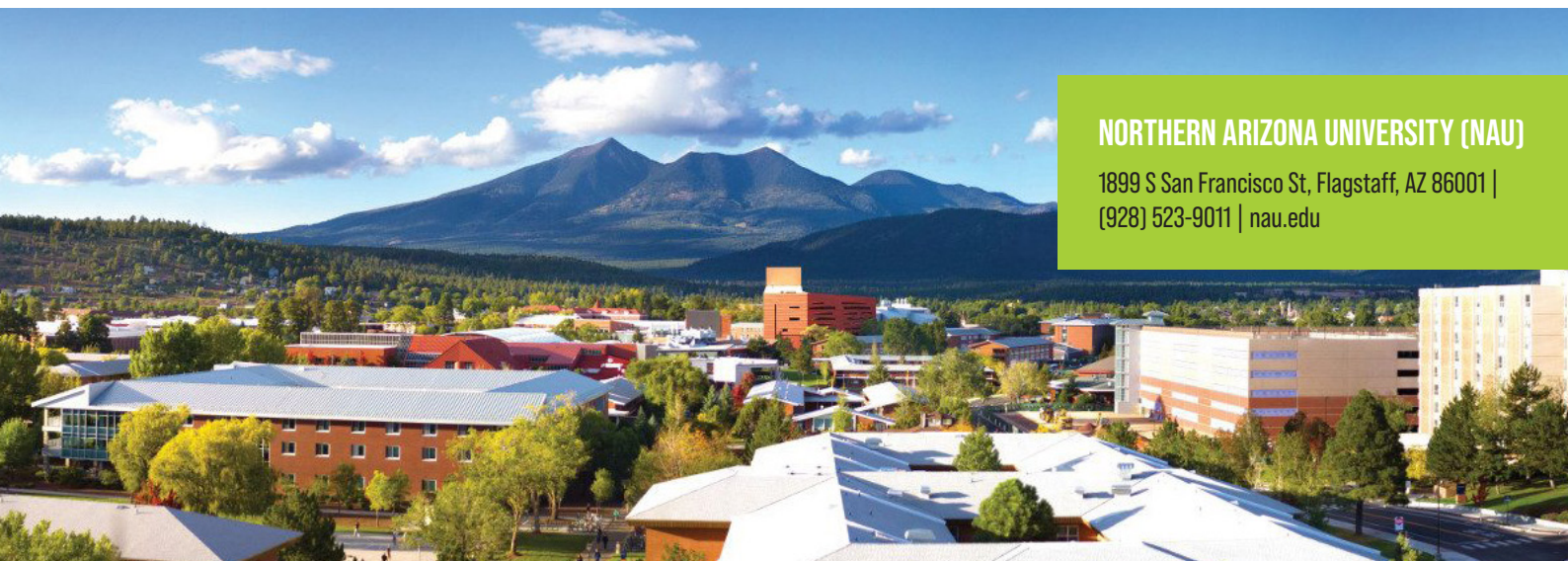

TAX INFORMATION

STATE INCOME TAX

Arizona imposes a graduated income tax similar to the Federal Income Tax. The 2009 tax rates range from 2.59% to 4.54% of Arizona Adjusted Gross Income. You may take a standard deduction or you may itemize deductions.

PROPERTY TAXES

Taxes are paid in two equal installments. The first installment is due October 1st. The second is due on March 1st of the following year. Maricopa County divides the tax into two values. The first is assessed on Limited Values (Primary) and the second is based on Full Cash Values (Secondary). Full Cash is the approximate property value based on the recent assessment by Maricopa County.

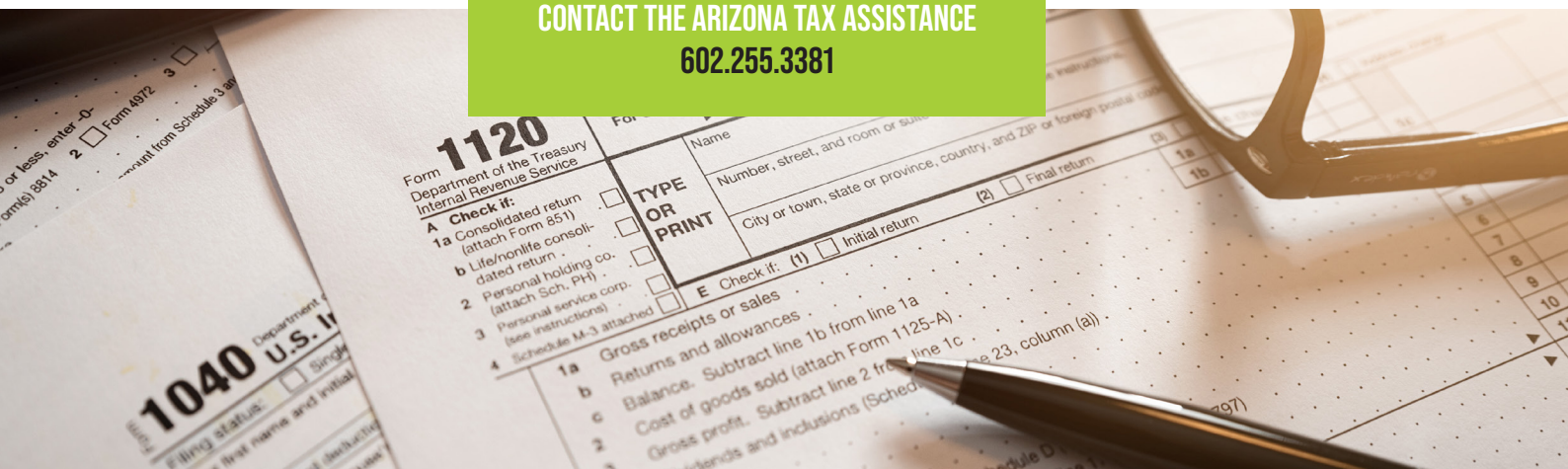

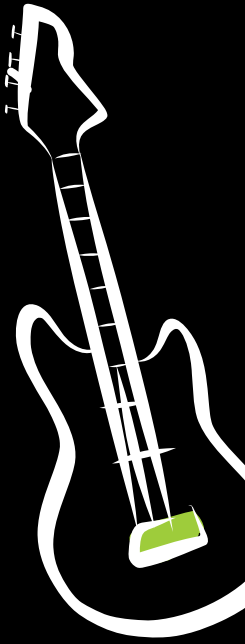
